

Successful completion of CCEBDM cycle-1 training program in Myanmar at 3 Centres

Glimpses of Sensitization workshop/orientation training



A total of 62 doctors at 3 centres in Myanmar region (2 in Yangon and 1 in Mandalay) were trained in the Cycle-1. This initiative is a joint collaboration of Public Health Foundation of India (PHFI) and Myanmar Diabetes Association (MMDA), Myanmar Society of Endocrinology and Metabolism (MSEM). Dr. Haresh, Dr. Deepak and Dr Santosh Kumar from PHFI attended the exit exam and certification ceremony conducted by MSEM and MMDA at Yangon and Mandalay centres.
